

NY Thermal Inc (NTI) Receives Innovation Recognition Award

NY Thermal Inc (NTI) has recently been recognized by the Government of New Brunswick as one of New Brunswick's most innovative companies of 2008. NTI president, Kevin Dennison, was presented with the Innovation Award on October 20th in Fredericton, New Brunswick, by Business Minister Greg Byrne for their newest product, The Matrix.

The Matrix, which is a single appliance that integrates a furnace, boiler, water heater, HRV and air conditioning, is an extremely compact, efficient unit that decreases green house gas emissions by as much as 6 tons annually. The Matrix is the only product to obtain Canada's new P10. IMS standard, for integrated mechanical systems and has achieved the Premium designation, which is the highest obtainable efficiency level.

NY Thermal recently constructed a 72,000 square foot, water front facility in Saint John, NB where they will house the production, training and research for the Matrix. NY Thermal was established in Sussex, NB, and remains a privately owned, family-run business.
